SACRED TABLE ZOOM TRAINING

ZOOM Opportunity to take part in the Diocesan SacredTable Initiative: On Saturday, January 10, from 9:00 a.m. to noon via Zoom, a repeat of the in-person event held on November 15 will occur. The first SacredTable presentation was very well received by catechists of children, youth, and adults, as well as by clergy members who attended. The SacredTable initiative offers training for parish leadership to better accompany parents and provides resources to support parents in their role as the first catechists of their children. The focus of Saturday's event was training parish leadership. Dr. Christine Taylor and two members of the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis Commission shared stories of the fruits they have seen in their ministries since beginning to use the skills taught during the session.

A few takeaways from those who participated:

- * I need to build a relationship with the parents by having conversations with them about where they are in their faith journey.
- * The importance of forming a relationship with parents and making them welcome when they do come.
- * Without first accompaniment and a faith foundation in the family, our efforts yield poor results. Education without formation bears little fruit.
- * Parent accompaniment is Necessary! (emphasis added by participant)
